



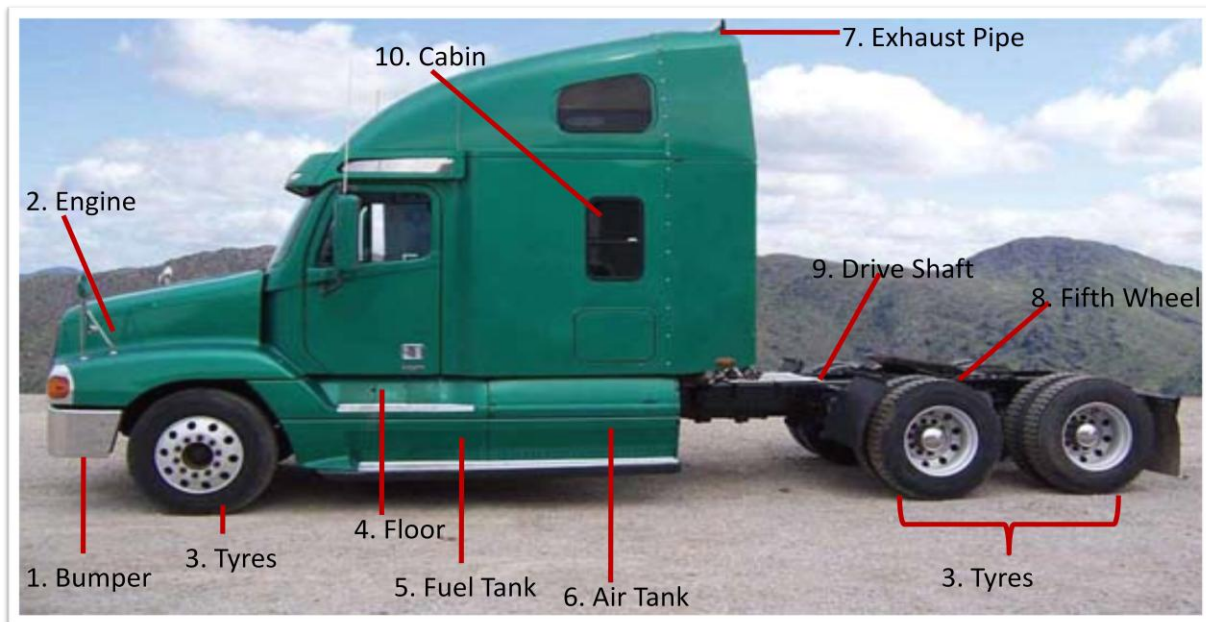

Bumper - Check the bumper: **Acceptable** **Unacceptable**

- a. Requires use of a flashlight and an inspection mirror
- b. Checking behind bumper for false compartments or hidden material

Engine - Check the engine: **Acceptable** **Unacceptable**

- a. Engine should be turned off.
- b. Requires use of a flashlight and inspection mirror.
- c. Check engine compartment, remove filter covers and filters

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Tyres - Check the tyres of the truck and the trailer: **Acceptable** **Unacceptable**

a. Use tool to hit tyres and vibrate them on the tractor and the trailer. They should sound and feel hollow.

b. Check the spare tyre on the trailer and tractor as well

Floor - Check the floor of the truck **Acceptable** **Unacceptable**

a. Ensure there are no people in the truck.

b. Lift the floor carpet to confirm there are no new repairs for secret compartment hidden in the floor.

Fuel Tanks - Check the fuel tanks **Acceptable** **Unacceptable**

a. Use a tool to tap the fuel tanks. They should sound like they contain fluid.

b. Use a flashlight to look inside the fuel tanks if possible.

Air Tanks - Check the air tanks **Acceptable** **Unacceptable**

a. Tap the tractor air tanks. They should sound hollow.

b. Tap the trailer air tanks for any weld marks or other signs of tampering.

Exhaust Pipe - Check the exhaust system & exhaust pipe **Acceptable** **Unacceptable**

a. Ensure there are not ropes or other items tied to the exhaust pipe or exhaust.

b. Ensure the exhaust pipe is not loose. It should also be hot if the engine has been on.

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Fifth Wheel - Check the fifth-wheel **Acceptable** **Unacceptable**

- a. Check the empty spaces for improper material.
- b. Check the battery areas to ensure they are secure and are free from improper materials.

Drive Shaft - Check the drive shafts **Acceptable** **Unacceptable**

- a. Inspect the drive shaft for any repairs or new paint.
- b. Use a tool to tap the drive shaft. It should sound hollow.

Cabin - Check the cab and storage compartments **Acceptable** **Unacceptable**

- a. Look inside and outside the storage compartments for improper contents.
