

## **PUBLIC ADVISORY #11**

### **Implementation of the Approved Suspension of the CET on Selected Renewable Energy and Energy Efficient Technologies**

---

The Ministry of Finance and the Public Service has advised the Jamaica Customs Agency, in a letter dated December 1, 2025, that in keeping with the decision by the COTED (Council for Trade and Economic Development) at its 61<sup>st</sup> Regular Meeting, Jamaica will fully suspend the Common External Tariff (CET) on the attached list of eight (8) renewable energy and energy efficient items.

**The suspension of the CET will be effective for the period January 1, 2026, to December 31, 2027.**

Additional National Code (ANC) EC4 is already in place and should be used to facilitate clearance.
